

Some IVC Transfer Information

2010-2011

Honors Program graduates transferred to a wide range of outstanding transfer institutions including Brown University, Caltech, UC Berkeley, UCLA, UC Irvine, UC Davis, UC San Diego, UC Santa Barbara, CSUF, and CSLB.

UCLA - 76% of IVC Honors Program TAP applicants accepted to UCLA (vs. 27% of non-TAP cc applicants statewide).

UC Berkeley – 42% of IVC Honors Program applicants accepted vs. 20% of non-honors IVC applicants and 26% of all freshmen applicants

The transfer data for '08 is in and IVC has a relatively distinguished record. Here it is:

For UCLA generally:

UCLA received 15,500 transfer applications for Fall 08. Of these, 3,300 were accepted (21.3%).

UCLA received 1500 HONORS transfer applications for Fall 08. Of these, 900 were accepted (60%).

IVC applications to UCLA:

08 -- IVC Honors applications to UCLA - 42, accepted - 39

07-- IVC Honors applications to UCLA - 21, accepted - 21.

Additionally, in '08, there were 8 transfers to Cal Berkeley, 3 to Columbia, and lots of transfers to other colleges.
